With the winter growing area in full swing, we are seeing the availability of produce continue to increase, along with some relief in the pricing on some of the usual items. We are seeing the price trend down on items such as certain Lettuce products and Broccoli. We are also seeing the product quality become much better. For example, the weights and sizes of all Lettuce has increased along with the quality.

We are hearing that the weather is still mild in the Yuma growing area with cooler nights and mornings affecting the rate of growth on some items causing the price on some items to continue to increase. They are even predicting rain for the weekend and early next week. We are seeing good volumes on items like Green Beans, Tomatoes, Zucchini and Cucumbers from Mexico as we continue with our import program. Still available from our local and mainland growers, a selection of hard Squash, all Cabbage, Beets, Turnips, Rutabagas and Potatoes.



#### **LETTUCE**

ICEBERG: We continue to have in stock the 24ct Cello and unwrapped product and our in-house chopped product.

**ROMAINE**: We will have good supplies available for the week. Romaine Hearts back in stock. We continue to have our in-house chopped Romaine product.

LEAF: We have 24ct California Red and Green Leaf available.

BUTTER: We have a good supply of 24ct GH and Field. TUSCAN SPRING MIX: We continue to stock the 3lbs case.

ARUGULA: We continue to stock the 2x2lbs. ARTISAN: We continue to stock 24cts.

**SPINACH W&T**: We have a good supply of 4x2.5lbs cases.



### **ONIONS / POTATOES**

ONIONS: The Onion market is experiencing upwards pressure. We have Red jumbo and Yellow in both jumbo / medium sizes. The quality

of Green Onion is good with large quantities being available.

SHALLOTS: Available in the 5lb whole or 2lb peeled.

POTATOES: Yellow and Red Nuggets, Roasters, Kennebec's, Yukon Gold, large Russets and Fingerlings. We continue to stock Yams and Sweet Potatoes.



### **PEPPERS**

BAGGED: There are limited supplies of bagged Peppers available in the 5/2lb size.

COLOURED: We have transitioned to the Mexican 11lb coloured Peppers. We will have Yellow and Red available for this week. There will also be limited quantities of the 11lb Orange BC available. We continue to have the 25lb Red & Green in stock as well.



### **SQUASH**

HARD: We continue to stock Acorn, Butternut, Kabocha, and Spaghetti Squash. As we move

forward in the winter season, we will start to see the local Squash finish. Delicata is now finished for the season.



### **BROCCOLI/CAULIFLOWER**

BROCCOLI: We will have steady supplies of the Domestic and Asian cut crowns as well as the 14ct bunch product. We are seeing the price

continue to trend downwards for the week.

CAULIFLOWER: We will have both the 9ct and 12ct available, the quality remains good. We are seeing the market price continue to trend upwards, higher again this week.

BROCCOLINI: We have a good supply of Broccolini which can be a nice change from Asparagus which is not available again this week.



### **TOMATOES**

**FULL SIZE**: We have 5x6's and Romas from Mexico again this week. 6x7 are still not available. We have

BC Beefsteak, Red On the vine.

SMALL: We have plenty of the 12x1pt Medley and 12x1pt Red Grape available.



### **CITRUS**

GRAPEFRUIT: We will have available again for this week, the 56ct Ruby Red.

**ORANGES:** We will be stocking 56ct, 113ct, and 138ct Californian Navels. Also, we will have limited supplies of the bulk and 4lb Mandarin Oranges.

LEMONS: We will have 140 Californian Lemons in stock. Good

LIMES: We are back to stocking the 175ct, we could see the price rise in the coming weeks due to the holidays.



### **MELONS**

CANTALOUPE: We will be stocking the 12ct product this week. The market is tight due to a lack of availability from decreased growth.

HONEYDEW: We will have 9ct available for this week. Limited availability.

WATERMELON: We have the regular size Watermelon to start the week, but we are seeing the market begin to tighten.



### BERRIES

We will have for next week, the 12/6oz Driscoll's Raspberries and Blueberries as well as the 8/1lb Strawberries.
