## **RHUBARB**

Rhubarb is tart and a bit sweet, with a crisp, celery-like texture. Despite being a vegetable, it is usually seen in desserts paired with sweet fruits like strawberries.

Rhubarb is surprisingly versatile and has a lot to bring to the table beyond the classic pie or crumble. Here are some of our tasty ways to use rhubarb:

- Roast or grill and add to a salad instead of roast carrots or beets.
- Use fresh in a salsa and pair with meat like pork.
- Stew alongside chicken and bold spices for a rainy spring day.
- Pickle with warm aromatics like cloves or star anise and pair with cheese or grilled steak.

However you eat them, enjoy them grown right here in British Columbia.



- 1. Preheat oven to 375°F.
- 2. Wash and rinse rhubarb and cut into ½" pieces.
- 3. Toss rhubarb with sugar, flour, and cinnamon. Place in a 2 qt baking dish.
- 4. In a separate bowl, combine topping ingredients with a fork or pastry cutter. Sprinkle over rhubarb mixture.
- 5. Bake for 35 minutes or until rhubarb is tender and topping is golden.
- 6. Cool 5-10 minutes before serving. Top with ice cream or cream.

Cucumbers and Rhubarb. We are also expecting this week, first of the season locally grown Romaine, Green Leaf and Red Leaf Lettuce.

### **LETTUCE**

ICEBERG: We will have in stock for the week, the Cello wrapped and liner product. Due to a stronger demand and cooler weather, we are seeing the prices of the head Lettuce products trend upwards for the week.

**ROMAINE**: We will have good supplies of the 24ct available for the week. We continue to have plenty of Romaine Hearts in stock. We also have our in-house chopped Romaine as a great labor saver. LEAF: We have both 24ct California Red and Green Leaf available

BUTTER: We will have available 12ct Hothouse Living Butter Lettuce this week. There is also the 24ct field Butter available.

TUSCAN SPRING MIX: We continue to have good stock of the 3lb

ARUGULA: We continue to stock the 2x2lbs. ARTISAN: We continue to stock 24cts.

**SPINACH W&T**: We have a good supply of 4x2.5lbs cases.



#### **ONIONS / POTATOES**

ONIONS: We are seeing the market remain stable on Onions this week. We will have the jumbo Red & Yellow available as well as a limited

amount of the medium Yellow. White Onions are now finished.

**SHALLOTS**: Available in 5lb whole or 2lb peeled.

POTATOES: The coloured Potatoes available for the week are Red Mediums and Nuggets, Yellow Nuggets as well as the Tri-colour Creamers. Look for the complete listings of items from "The Little Potato Company".

#### PEPPERS

BAGGED: We will have in stock for the week, a BC Hot House 10/2lb bagged Pepper.

COLOURED: There will be a good supply of the colored Peppers. We will have the BC 11lb Red, Orange and Yellow. With the Mexican season coming to an end, we will be moving to the Californian product over the week.

#### **SQUASH**

HARD: We are now finding that the Mexican product is starting to wind down. We will then move to Californian products which will cause

pricing to rise. We will have the both, the 22lb and 40lb volume filled cases of green Zucchini available for the week. The product remains goods at a reasonable price.



#### **BROCCOLI/CAULIFLOWER**

BROCCOLI: We are still seeing a good supply of Broccoli. We will have the Domestic and Asian cut crowns as well as the 14ct bunch product.

Due to the strong demand and cooler weather, we are seeing the price trend up again for the week.

CAULIFLOWER: We will have both the 9ct and 12ct available, the quality remains good. As with the Broccoli the cooler weather and high demand is forcing the price higher for the week.



#### **TOMATOES**

FULL SIZE: We will have the 5x6 and 6x7 Mexican product for the week but with the volume that is available, we are seeing the price begin to trend upwards. We will also have the Beefsteak, OTV's and Roma's available.

SMALL: Our small Tomatoes for the week will be the Grape and Cherry available in the 12/1pt case. There will also be the 12/1pt and as one of the feature items, the 10lb bulk Symphony product will be available.



ORANGES: We are seeing the California product come to an end. We will have available for the week, 48, 56 & 113ct China Navels. All signs show that the

quality is good on this product. There will also be a Peruvian Satsuma Mandarin 10kg available.

LEMONS: We will have the 115& 140ct Lemons in stock for this week. With the quality remaining good, the price remains stable. LIMES: We will have in stock the 175ct size available this week. Pricing will remain stable but high again for the week.



#### **MELONS**

CANTALOUPE: We will have the 12ct Mexican product this week, with the price increasing.
